Mercer University's Georgia Educators Networking to Revolutionize and Transform Education (GENERATE) teacher residency program provides a path for teachers without certification or career changers to obtain either Bachelor of Science in Education (B.S.Ed.) or Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.) degrees, become certified teachers in Georgia, and teach in high-need content areas.

GENERATE grant Pays for ALL Tuition & FEES

The program provides individuals with a combination of the following:

- Professional development
- Mentoring
- Professional learning communities
- Embedded endorsement



GENERATE Certification Programs

I am seeking a bachelor's degree. Bachelor of Science in Education (B.S.Ed.)

Early Learning and Development (Birth-Kindergarten) + embedded Special Education Preschool (Ages 3–5) endorsement.

Early Learning and Development is also offered as a nondegree, certification-only program option.

Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.)

- Middle Grades Education (Grades 4-8)
- Secondary Education (Grades 6-12)
- P-12 Education (Grades P-12)

Candidates also earn a Computer Science endorsement.



Exploring Mercer's Initial Certification Program Delivery

Bachelor of Science in Education (B.S.Ed.) | Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.)

FORMAT			
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- 25% On-campus, Saturday -based, roughly 1 meeting per month, per class
- 25% Virtual asynchronous- work through at your own pace
- 50% Virtual synchronous- live instruction, remote learning

LOCATION

Macon (One Saturday Each Month)

COMPLETION TIME

24–30 months, depending on approved transfer credits

18–24 months

START TIME

August and October 2023; January and March 2024

August and October 2023; March 2024



Scholarship Service Agreement

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As a condition of the grant program, candidates must commit to serving at a school within a partnering school district for three years after degree completion. Upon admission to the program, candidates sign a Scholarship Service Agreement affirming their willingness to serve within the district where their student teaching is completed. If candidates cannot meet this requirement, the grant will be converted to a low-interest loan and is subject to the repayment schedule outlined in the agreement.

- Specific requirements for ALL initial certification programs.
- GACE Exams (ethics & content)

 - If a program is <u>NOT</u> listed on the GaPSC website, it is not a true initial certification program for becoming a certified teacher in Georgia.
